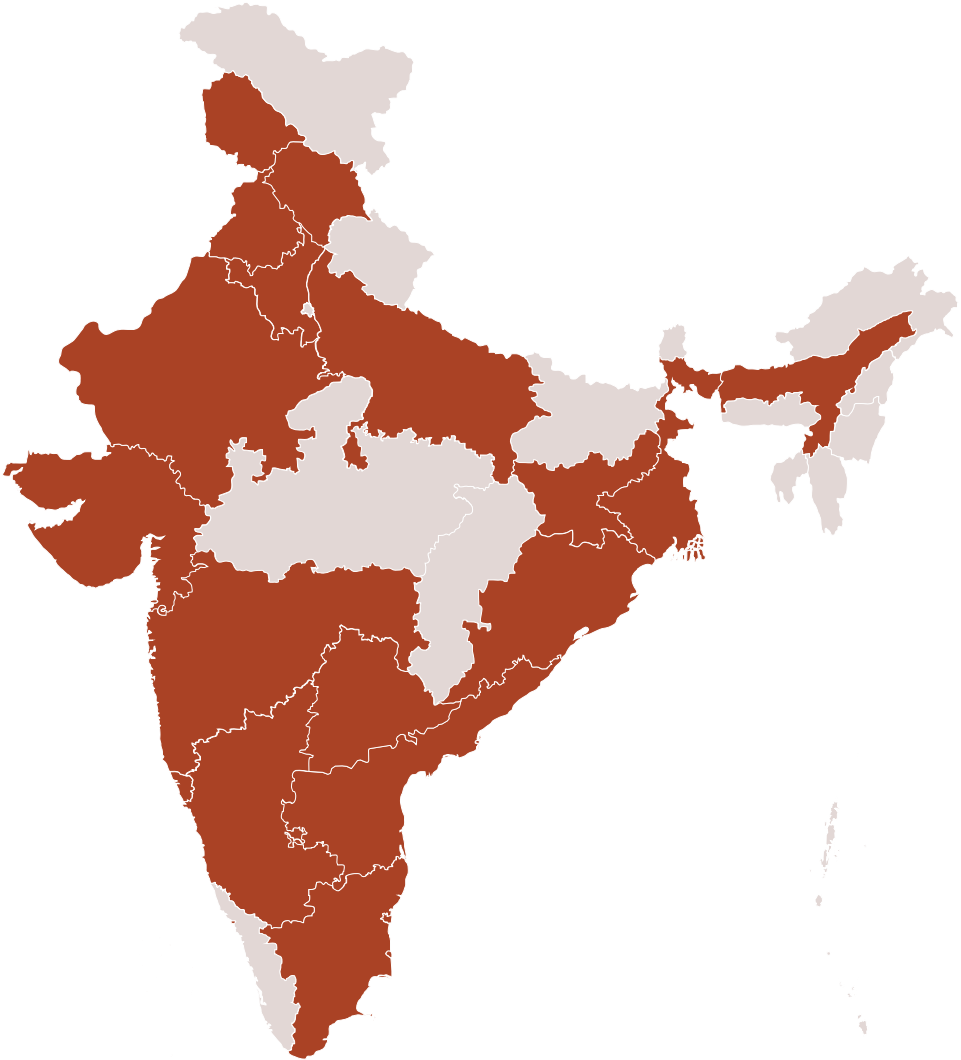

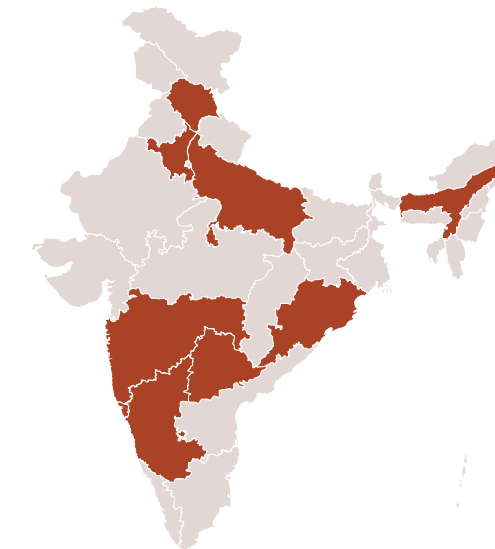

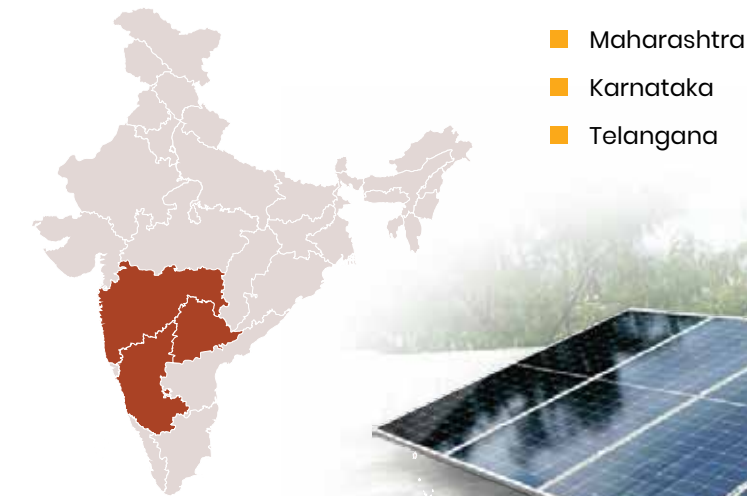

Project Kanchan promotes aerobic bio-composting, converting organic waste from urban markets into nutrient-rich organic compost that enhances soil health and fertility. At the heart of this initiative are Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs), who manage the composting sites with ownership and pride, turning waste management into an economic and environmental opportunity. By combining women's empowerment with sustainable waste solutions, Project Kanchan is the first of its kind programme that fosters circular economy practices, improves livelihoods, and creates healthier, more resilient communities – nurturing both the land and the hands that care for it.

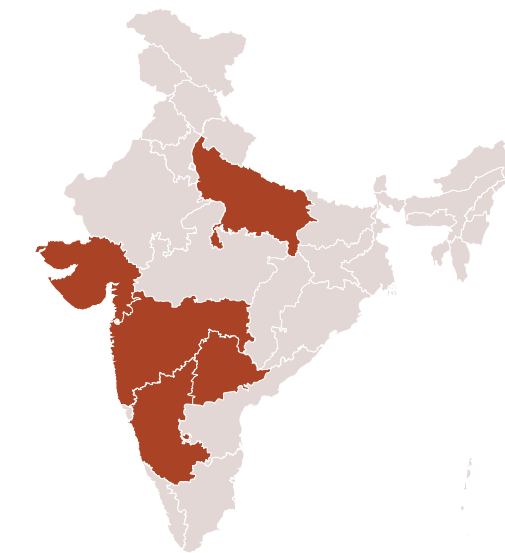

With an Automatic Weather Station and Soil Testing Lab providing real-time climate and soil insights, the CoE showcases diverse, high-impact farming models — including Agroforestry, Horticulture, Regenerative, SRI, Low-Tunnel, and Mulching — to boost productivity while restoring soil health. The intervention integrates bio-composting units, sprinkler and drip irrigation demos, and a climate-proof livestock shed, promoting water-efficient, climate-resilient techniques for year-round agricultural stability. Additionally, this is accompanied by a Farmer Training Room established for continuous skill development, transforming the CoE into a dynamic knowledge hub that empowers farmers to build climate-resilient, food-secure, and sustainable rural communities.

India's cultural heritage is deeply interwoven with its traditional crafts, many of which are at risk of fading away due to industrialisation and modern manufacturing processes. One such endangered art form was Sujani weaving, a unique double-cloth technique from Bharuch, Gujarat, with a history spanning over 600 years. Once a thriving industry with thousands of artisans, Sujani weaving had nearly disappeared, with only two families struggling to keep it alive. As this time-honored craft faced extinction, urgent intervention was needed to ensure its survival.

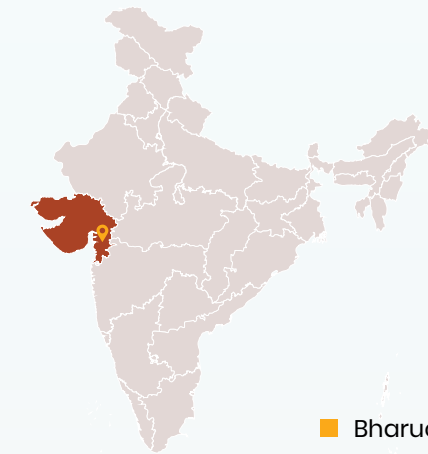

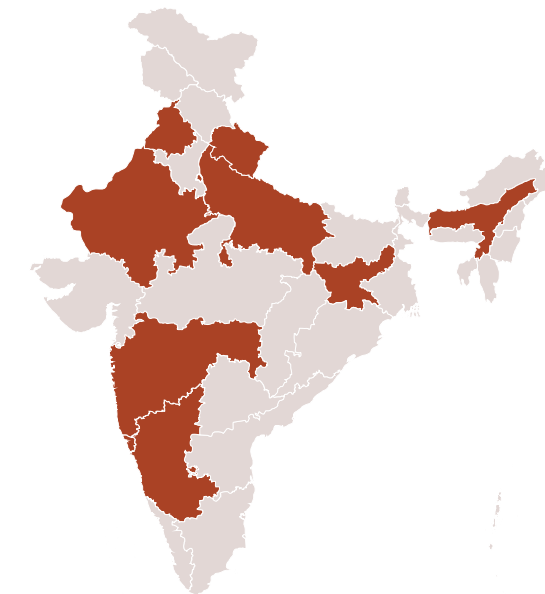
